

(BOM September 2019) AUTUMN TINTS 14"

Color 1 needs: one 2-1/2" x 18" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 10" strip

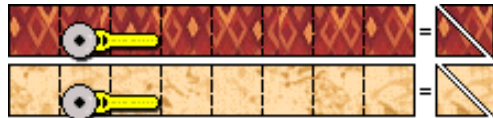
Color 2 needs: one 2-1/2" square AND one 2-7/8" x 23" strip (half square triangle color)

Color 3 needs: one 2-7/8" x 23" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 20" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 26" strip (light fabric for background)

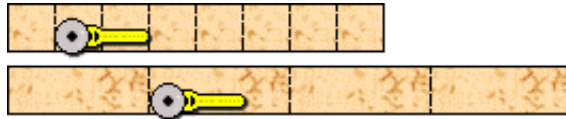
Start by marking and cutting the Color 1 2-1/2" x 18" strip into four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. Then mark and cut the Color 1 2-1/2" x 10" strip into four 2-1/2" squares. Cut ONE 2-1/2" square of Color 2 as well...



Now mark and cut the Color 2 and Color 3 2-7/8" x 23" strips into eight 2-7/8" squares of each. Cut each of these squares in half once on the diagonal to make sixteen half square triangles of each...



Next mark and cut the Color 3 2-1/2" x 20" strip into eight 2-1/2" squares. Mark and cut the Color 3 2-1/2" x 26" strip into four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...



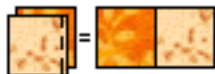
Sew each of the Color 3 half square triangles to a Color 2 half square triangle, right sides together, and using a SCANT 1/4" seam. Press seam allowances towards the darker fabric...



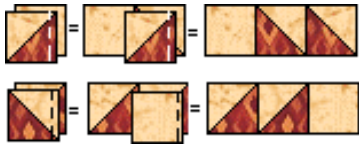
Sew units of two half squares, making two in each arrangement shown below...



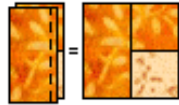
Then sew four units as shown at below, made of a Color 1 and Color 3 2-1/2" square each



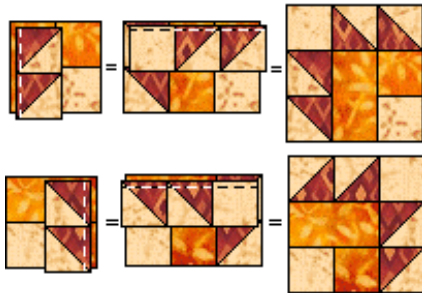
Next, make two of each of the units shown at left, noting that they are made up of the same units, but sewn in a different orientation. Each made of a Color 1 and Color 3 for a 2-1/2" square each



Now sew four of the units shown at left, using Color 1 rectangle and a pair of pre sewn squares...



Make two of each of the next units shown below...



Then piece the block, using the Color 3 long rectangles, and the Color 2 small square as spacers between the units we just made above. Make rows, and then sew the rows together to complete the block.
