Mystery Quilt: Hawaii Ocean

Block of the month Donna Kanealii, Joanne How

August 2017 Block of the Month: "Honu"

12" finished block - 12 1/2 " unfinished

Colors: light "Hawaii ocean color" for background (blue or turquoise or green) and your choice of two color hues for the turtle

Materials Required: (for one block)

- 13" square for background (or bigger)
- 8 ½ circle for yoyo
- 8" square for turtle
- 8" square piece of fusible web

Assembly Instructions:

- Trace the turtle design onto fusible web.
- Rough cut the design.
- Fuse onto the back side of your turtle fabric
- After fusing, cut out the design on the drawn line and place on your background, roughly centering.
- Remove paper backing of the design
- Fuse the piece to the background
- Stitch around the applique, hand or machine stitch
- Trim block to an exact 12 ½
- Hand or machine applique the yoyo

Making the Yoyo:

- Use a single strand of quilting thread.
- Turn under 3/8" as you sew a running stitch around the circle.
- Stitches should be at least ½"
- Pull up the threads to draw the stitching tightly to the center.
- Tie a very good knot.
