## (BOM September 2019) AUTUMN TINTS 14"

Color 1 needs: one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ strip AND one 2-1/2" x 10" strip
Color 2 needs: one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square AND one $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ strip (half square triangle color) Color 3 needs: one $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ strip AND one 2-1/2" x $20^{\prime \prime}$ strip AND one 2-1/2" x 26 " strip (light fabric for background)

Start by marking and cutting the Color $1 \quad 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ strip into four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Then mark and cut the Color1 $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strip into four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut ONE 2-1/2" square of Color 2 as well...


Now mark and cut the Color 2 and Color 3 2-7/8" x $23^{\prime \prime}$ strips into eight 2-7/8" squares of each. Cut each of these squares in half once on the diagonal to make sixteen half square triangles of each...


Next mark and cut the Color $32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " strip into eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Mark and cut the Color 3 2-1/2" x $26^{\prime \prime}$ strip into four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles...


Sew each of the Color 3 half square triangles to a Color 2 half square triangle, right sides together, and using a SCANT $1 / 4$ " seam. Press seam allowances towards the darker fabric...


Sew units of two half squares, making two in each arrangement shown below...


Then sew four units as shown at below, made of a Color 1 and Color 3 2-1/2" square each


Next, make two of each of the units shown at left, noting that they are made up of the same units, but sewn in a different orientation. Each made of a Color 1 and Color 3 for a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square each


Now sew four of the units shown at left, using Color 1 rectangle and a pair of pre sewn squares...


Make two of each of the next units shown below...


Then piece the block, using the Color 3 long rectangles, and the Color 2 small square as spacers between the units we just made above. Make rows, and then sew the rows together to complete the block.
