

# CRAZY ANNE 10”      Make two blocks

Color 1 gold one 5" x 9" rectangle

Color 2 light green one 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip

Color 3 cream one 5" x 9" rectangle AND one 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip

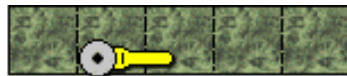
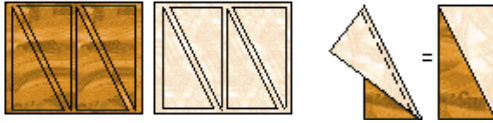
Color 4 dark green one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip

Half square rectangles are tuff. You need to make four. You have three options.

**Option one:** use color 3, one fabric for the rectangle measured at 2.5x 4.5

**Option two:** Make two rectangles at 2.75 x 5.25. Lay both fabrics facing up and cut diagonal. Swap fabrics and sew on the diagonal.

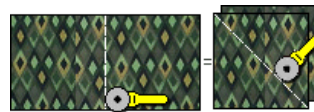
**Option three:** go to website [quiltingcache.com](http://quiltingcache.com) look up block; click on the block go to the template and paper piece.



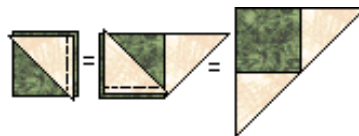
Then mark and cut the Color 2 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip into five 2-1/2" squares...



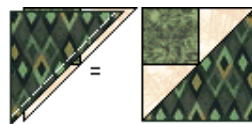
Next mark and cut the Color 3 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strip into four 2-7/8" squares. Stack and cut the squares once on the diagonal to make eight half square triangles...



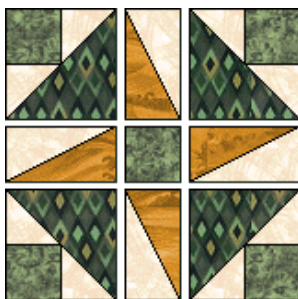
Mark and cut the Color 4 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip into two 4-7/8" squares. Stack and cut the squares once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles...



First sew a Color 3 half square triangle to the right side of a Color 2 square, using a SCANT 1/4" seam. Sew another Color 3 half square triangle to the bottom edge of the Color 2 square. Press seam allowances towards the triangles. Make four of these units...



Sew each of the previously made units to a Color 4 half square triangle, pressing seam allowances towards the larger triangles. Make four of these



Piece the block by joining the units. First make rows, and then sew the rows together to make the block. Alternate pressing directions with each addition.
