## NOVEMBER BOM - RIBBON BORDER

Last Block for this Project - December assemble your panel. New BOM Project starts January 2021

This is a border for your project. You determine the size and shape. It can go across the top, down both sides, all the way around, any way you want.

The size blocks can vary. Take different size squares of your ribbon fabric and see what size you like in comparison to your tree and star.

Ribbon fabric - creates the parallelogram. 1/2 square triangle.
Background fabric - $1 / 4$ square triangle
Accent fabric - $1 / 4$ square triangle. Pull a color from your ribbon fabric if a print. If a solid make it contrast.

## NOTES:

The size can vary because it will be a border and is not having to match up with other piecing blocks.
Make three sample blocks to test that you like your choices. Three gives you the parallelogram and the secondary square.

Instructions:
Sew short sides of $1 / 4$ square triangles together. SEW THE SAME SIDES, DON'T ROTATE COLORS.

Sew $1 / 2$ square of the two $1 / 4$ squares to the $1 / 2$ square triangle on the longest side. Nipping off the tips helps for a cleaner finish. Trim edges for a accurate square.

Sew blocks togethers, with the background fabric on the outside. Create a parallelogram with the ribbon fabric and a square with the accent fabric as you sew them together.

Decide how many sides you want this on your project. For the corner block end with the ribbon fabric facing down on the top row. The sides will join creating a parallelogram.
