Make an ombré Christmas tree quilt in green and red color ways only. Use a mix of solids and prints, no less than 12 total. No limitations in size. The quilt has to be finished. May decorate the tree with ornaments or stars in any color, but not necessary for the challenge.

This is a challenge to test your skills in determining color value accurately.

Red glasses are helpful, but simply taking a photo of the selected fabric and turning the color photo into a black and white will give you an accurate reading of the color values.

But try to select your fabric with just your eyes first before using any other tools This will truly sharpen your skill set to see color value at a glance.

Value: a measure of how light or dark a color is while the hue remains constant.

Tint: any hue with white added (Lighter) This increases the value.

Shade: any hue with black added (Darker) This lowers the value

Tone: any hue with grey added (Medium)
