OCTOBER 2022 BOM - Spooky Street

DUE DATE: NOVEMBER MEETING



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Scraps in all your Halloween prints and coordinating solid colors

Steam a seam 2 or other fusible product 24" x 24" piece of cream or white fabric

HOW TO ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK:

Draw a 15" circle on a piece of paper.

Divide this circle into wedges in the number of houses you want to make, in different sizes and cut apart. Cut an inch off the bottom (Narrowest part) of each blade. Cut off multiple "Heights" of the widest part of the blades where your roofs will be attached. When placed together, your circle should look like the second photo. (Please note: The center wasn't cut out in the photo.)











Place each triangle on a chosen piece of fabric and cut adding a ¼" sewing allowance on each side. Sew all the triangles together, matching the bottom edges. Iron seams into each blade so they will have a clean edge, with the raw edges ironed under each blade. Place the circle of houses in the center of the background fabric (White) and pin. Stitch down on each seam to secure the blades before attaching the roofs and center fussy cut center.

Make a 3" fussy cut for the center, prepare with fusing

Place in the center of your houses and iron on

Prepare your solid black fabric with fusing to cut the roofs

Prepare other coordinating solid color fabric for adding the doors and windows with fusing Cut your roofs and windows in any shape you want and attach to the sewn Dresden plate.

Use decorative stitches, different colors to make this more interesting or spookier...

Will make an awayaway door handing.

Go crazy and add spiders and spider webs.......Will make an awesome door hanging!



If you want your block to be smaller, simply make your initial circle the size you want. The center fussy cut will have to be sized accordingly. All other instructions remain the same.
