HQG 2025 Quilt Show: Lucky, We Live Hawai'i Reference Copy of Entry Form – Not for Submission



General Rules for All Categories

- 1. Entry Limits Submit one form per quilt. Limits per member:
 - One (1) Upcycle
 - Two (2) Wearable Art
 - One (1) Challenge
 - Five (5) total in other categories
- 2. Eligibility Quilts must:
 - Be sewn by an HQG member.
 - Not have been exhibited at a previous HQG quilt show.
- 3. **Structure** The majority of the quilt must include three distinct layers:
 - A quilt top, middle layer, and backing.
 - Exceptions: Cathedral Windows and Yo-Yo quilts do not require three layers.
- 4. Quilting Requirements Quilts must be quilted by hand, machine, or tied.
- 5. Labeling Attach a label with at least your full name (and quilt name if possible):
 - Quilts: Sew or fuse the label to the back.
 - Upcycle projects: Sew the label somewhere on the project.
- 6. Hanging Sleeve Attach a finished sleeve to the top back edge.
 - Quilts up to 24" wide: Triangle sleeves are acceptable (provide dowel if possible).
 - Quilts 60"–100" wide: Split the sleeve into two sections with a small center gap.
 - Quilts over 100" wide: Split into three sections with gaps in between.

Additional Requirements

- Challenge Option 1) AMAKUA (Ancestral Spirits) or Option 2) INDIVIDUALS WHO MADE A DIFFERENCE, A PLACE THAT IS SACRED, ICONIC, or SIGNIFICANT IN THE HAWAI'IAN CULTURE, A PLACE YOU FEEL CONNECTED TO, A FOOD ONE CAN ONLY FIND IN HAWAI'I
 - No smaller than 24" x 24". No larger than 50" x 60".
 - All techniques are acceptable. NO PATTERNS!
 - Have an aesthetic representing the uniqueness of Hawai'i.
 - An explanation of why the selection was made, and how it has made an impact or is special to you, so the viewer gets a better understanding of your work and sees how your creativity comes alive (50-75 words).
- 2. Only Solids Quilts / Small
 - No smaller than 20" x 20", finished.
 - Solid colors only. Minimum of 6 colors, maximum of 10.
 - Black must be one of the shades (colors) you choose. (FYI. Black is not a color, but the lack of light. It is a shade.)

3. First Timers / Youth

- First quilt entered in an HQG quilt show.
- Youth = Anyone under 18 years of age and sponsored by an HQG member.
- Can be any technique, any size.

4. Upcycle

• A photo of the ORIGINAL item is required with the entry to show the transformation of the recycled material.

1. Entry Form Deadline

- Submit all entry forms online by Monday, March 17, 2025, at midnight HST.

2. Quilt Submission Deadline

- Bring finished quilts in a bag (jumbo storage bags with handles are ideal) to the Monday, March 24 meeting.
- Challenge Quilts: Must be in a separate bag and delivered to the Challenge quilt area for voting during the meeting.
