Join Us for Block of the Month!— A Traditional Block and a Modern Variation - MaryAnn Jones, Lily Kamikihara and Teresa Sakurada

Traditional - Courthouse Block

- 1. Cut one 5" square for your center.
- 2. Cut two light fabric 2.75"x 5" strips.
- 3. Cut two dark fabric 2.75" x 9.5" strips.
- 4. Using a 1/4" seam, sew the light fabrics with <u>right sides together</u> to the top and bottom of the center square. Press the seam allowances towards the strips.
- 5. Using a 1/4" seam, sew the dark fabrics with <u>right sides together</u> to the left and right sides of the center square and strips in #4. Press the seam allowances towards the newly added strips.

Modern Variation – Courthouse Block

- 1. Cut one 1.5" square for your center. Cut two light fabric 1.5" squares for round 1 top and bottom.
- 2. Cut two dark fabric 1.5 " x 3.5" strips for round 1 left and right. Cut two light fabric 1.5 " x 3.5" strips for round 2 top and bottom.
- 3. Cut two dark fabric 1.5 " x 5.5" strips for round 2 left and right. Cut two light fabric 2.5 " x 5.5" strips for round 3 top and bottom.
- 4. Cut two light fabric 2.5 " x 9.5" strips for round 3 left and right.
- 5. Using a 1/4" seam, sew the round 1 top and bottom light fabrics with <u>right sides together</u> to the top and bottom of the center square. Press the seam allowances towards the strips.
- 6. Using a 1/4" seam, sew the round 1 left and right dark fabrics with <u>right sides together</u> to the left and right sides of the center square and strips in #5. Press the seam allowances towards the newly added strips.
- 7. Continue sewing the strips for round 2 to the top and bottom of the block. Then sew the strips for round 2 left and right to the block. Next sew the round 3 top and bottom strips and lastly the round 3 left and right strips.
